Ada County Paramedics Open Station #52 Serving Residents of South Boise

Ribbon Cutting & Community Open House Scheduled for August 13th

(Boise, ID) – The Ada County Paramedics Department is proud to announce the opening of its newest Paramedics station in south Boise. Station #52, located in a small business complex off of Victory Road on Featherly Way, now houses a round-the-clock Paramedics crew devoted to serving Ada County residents living in the south Boise area. Previously, Paramedics crews serving this area have been based out of St. Luke's Hospital West and St. Alphonsus Hospital on Cole Road.

The public and media are invited to attend a ribbon cutting ceremony and open house at Station #52 on Wednesday, August 13th. Ada County Paramedics look forward to offering brief tours of their new station and explaining the advanced life support equipment housed inside the ambulances dispatched from the station. Additionally, a \$5 discount will be offered to anyone signing up for a *Neighbors For Life* (NFL) membership at the event. Similar to the popular Life Flight program, *Neighbors For Life* works like a supplement to existing health insurance or Medicare/Medicaid coverage. NFL members with health insurance will never have to pay for emergency ambulance transport services from Ada County Paramedics. Uninsured NFL members are only responsible for the first \$100 of emergency ambulance transport costs.
