

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ADA COUNTY CODE, BY AMENDING TITLE II CHAPTERS 2, 3, AND 4, ADDING NEW SECTIONS PROVIDING THAT THE EXCRETION OF HUMAN WASTE, OR ANIMAL WASTE, EXCEPT IN DESIGNATED RESTROOM FACILITIES, IN ANY COUNTY PARK, PARKING LOT, OR RECREATION AREA IS A VIOLATION OF COUNTY ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED THAT ADA COUNTY CODE, TITLE II, CHAPTERS 2,3, AND 4, BE AMENDED BY THE ADDITION OF NEW SUBSECTIONS AS FOLLOWS:

TITLE II

CHAPTER 2

COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS

2-2-5 C 1:

A. No person owning or having care, custody, possession or control of a dog within County parks, recreation areas or river bike path routes shall:

- i.) Fail to have in his/her possession the equipment necessary to remove his/her dog's fecal matter when accompanied by said dog; or
- ii.) Fail to remove the fecal matter deposited by his/her dog before leaving the immediate area where the fecal matter was deposited.
- iii.) Violations of Section 2-2-5 C 1 A. (i) and/or (ii) are each infractions and are each punishable by a \$100.00 fine.

2-3-4 E:

1. No person owning or having care, custody, possession or control of a dog on the Western Idaho Fairgrounds shall:

- a.) Fail to have in his/her possession the equipment necessary to remove his/her dog's fecal matter when accompanied by said dog in any park; or
- b.) Fail to remove the fecal matter deposited by his/her dog in any park before leaving the immediate area where the fecal matter was deposited.
- c.) Violations of Section 2-3-4 E 1. (a.) and/or (b.) are each infractions and are each punishable by a \$100.00 fine.

2-4-4 D:

1. No person owning or having care, custody, possession or control of a dog within a County park, recreation area or parking lot shall:

- a.) Fail to have in his/her possession the equipment necessary to remove his/her dog's fecal matter when accompanied by said dog in any park; or
- b.) Fail to remove the fecal matter deposited by his/her dog in any park before leaving the immediate area where the fecal matter was deposited.
- c.) Violation of Section 2-4-4 D 1. (a.) and/or (b.) are each infractions and are each punishable by a \$100.00 fine.

2-2-6 I: To promote and protect the public health of the inhabitants of Ada County, it shall be a misdemeanor for any person to excrete human waste, except in designated restroom facilities, in any Ada County park, parking lot, or recreation area.

1. For purposes of the above section, the following definitions shall apply:

a.) **EXCRETION**

The discharge of human waste from the body, including the acts of defecation and urination

b.) **HUMAN WASTE**

Human feces or human urine.

2-3-5 A 6: To promote and protect the public health of the inhabitants of Ada County, it shall be a misdemeanor for any person to excrete human waste, except in designated restroom facilities, at the Western Idaho Fairgrounds or parking area.

a.) For purposes of the above section, the following definition shall apply:

i.) **EXCRETION**

The discharge of human waste from the body, including the acts of defecation and urination

ii.) **HUMAN WASTE**

Human feces or human urine.

2-4-4 D: To promote and protect the public health of the inhabitants of Ada County, it shall be a misdemeanor for any person to excrete human waste, except in designated restroom facilities, in any Ada County park, parking lot, or recreation area.

1. For purposes of the above section, the following definition shall apply:

a.) **EXCRETION**

The discharge of human waste from the body, including the acts of defecation and urination

b.) **HUMAN WASTE**

Human feces or human urine.
