

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SOLICITATION, PARKING, CAMPING AND TRESPASSING AT THE ADA COUNTY PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING AND PARKING LOTS THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ADA COUNTY, IDAHO, THAT ADA COUNTY CODE, TITLE 2, CHAPTER 4, BE AMENDED TO ADD SECTION 2-4-6 AS FOLLOWS:

2-4-6: GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

A. Solicitation and Distribution of Literature:

1. No private business or person may directly or indirectly solicit business in or on the property of the Public Safety Building without the permission of the Ada County Sheriff or the Ada County Board of Commissioners. The term “solicitation” includes the distribution of business cards, print advertising, apparel with business advertising larger than 1 inch lettering or other written information and/or literature. No one may leave a vehicle that displays business advertisements in the Public Safety Building parking lots while not conducting lawful business in the Public Safety Building.

B. Parking, Camping and Parking Lot Usage Regulations:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on, or own any vehicle found to be parked on or in any areas on the Ada County Public Safety Building property, including the parking lot in violation of posted parking restrictions. It shall also be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle or to own any vehicle found to be parked on any area blocking an emergency exit, fire lane, or access point to a public parking area and/or public parking space. It shall also be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle or to own any vehicle found to be parked on any Public Safety Building property, including the parking lot, if the person is not then conducting business in the Public Safety Building.

2. Overnight camping or parking is not permitted on any portion of the Public Safety Building grounds and parking lots except as authorized in writing by the Sheriff, Police Chief, or their designee.

3. No person shall knowingly enter the restricted areas of the Public Safety Building or its adjacent property without authorization. It shall be a misdemeanor for any person to violate the provisions of any rule or regulation adopted by the Sheriff and the Board of County Commissioners. All such rules will be conspicuously posted at each entrance to the Public Safety Building. Crossing over or through a fence onto the Public Safety Building shall be a violation regardless of signage.

C. Pets Policy:

Members of the public are prohibited from bringing pets onto the Public Safety Building property, including parking lots, with the exception of disability related guide dogs and law enforcement K-9's. Dogs, which are permitted, must be on a leash. This ordinance does not prohibit pets that are left in vehicles while the owner/caretaker is conducting lawful business at the PSB.

D. Violation:

Violation of this chapter shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punishable by imprisonment in the county jail for a period not to exceed six (6) months or by a fine not to exceed three hundred dollars (\$300.00) or by both as provided in Idaho Code, section 18-113. Each violation shall constitute a separate offense. Any vehicle found parked in violation of this chapter may be cited, and/or removed at the expense of the owner. (Ord. 132, 7-18-1984; amd.
