

## DIRECTIONS FOR DOWNLOADING CORNER RECORD UPDATES

- The first step is to make sure you have room on your computer to load 300-400 MB of files. Then copy all the files from the Corner Record CD issued by the County Surveyor, to all survey firms in the spring of 2001, to your hard drive. This will load all the .cal image files and the .svd pagelist file. The pagelist file is the index for all the image files (.cal) and must be updated for each change in images.
- Log on to web site: <http://www.adaweb.net/devserv/survey/home.html> to go to the Ada County Surveyors Home Page.  
You can also go to: <http://www.adaweb.net>, then go to Development Services, then Ada County Surveyor's Homepage (click on blue letters).
- Under - **No. 14. List of Corner Records (CP&F's) Database**, click on blue letters, which will bring up Corner Perpetuation and Filing Database.
- Then click on the red letters **Updates** which brings up the page called New Updates for CP&F by Date.
- Then click on a zip file that has a date. This should give you the option to open it or download it to your computer's hard drive.
- Then unzip the file to get at the image (.cal) files. These files were recorded during that time period. Copy these files to the same directory as the existing images from the CD.
- Each calendar date zip file can be downloaded which are small and easier to download or they can all be downloaded from the TOTALNEW.zip file which combines all the image files to that date. Currently that file is 5MB and can take a while to download.
- Also, download the current "pagelist.svd" file to this same directory. This provides the list and index to all the image files. Click on Svreader.exe, open Pagelist.svd, Click OK and the new list should be visible.

To summarize, you need to have all the existing files from the CD in the one directory on your computer, and you need to download 2 files to update the Corner Records, i.e. the most recent .cal files and the most recent pagelist.svd file. It's that simple.
