

AT A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF ADA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, STATE OF IDAHO, ON THE 2ND DAY OF MARCH, 2010, THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS APPROVED AND ADOPTED, TO WIT:

WHEREAS, the Board of Ada County Commissioners believes it is prudent for the Ada County Weed, Pest & Mosquito (WPM) Abatement District to have a Comprehensive Action Plan for managing noxious weeds, pests and mosquitoes in Ada County, concerned with protecting human health and promoting healthy lifestyles through increasing the opportunity for outdoor and recreational activities within the County by the implementation of a WPM Comprehensive Action Plan.

WHEREAS, the WPM Comprehensive Action Plan outlines administrative and field operations including education, mapping, trapping, surveillance, enforcement procedures, and control and eradication of listed pests through best management practices by implementation of an Integrated Pest Management approach, which includes the application of pesticides and, if necessary, aerial spraying of pesticides appearing on the Idaho Department of Agriculture's approved pesticide list.

WHEREAS, the Ada County WPM Abatement District is governed and guided by state statute and associated rules and regulations, and Chapter 8, Title 5 of the Ada County Code.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, the Board of Ada County Commissioners deems it appropriate to adopt the WPM Comprehensive Action Plan for Ada County.
