

AT A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF ADA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, STATE OF IDAHO, ON THE 16TH DAY OF MARCH, 2010, THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED, TO WIT:

WHEREAS, the Board of Ada County Commissioners believes it is prudent to have a suitability determination by a site advisory team, pursuant to I.C. § 67-6529D(2) with respect to a proposed confined animal feeding operation (“CAFO”) being considered for a parcel of property located approximately 10 miles south of Interstate 84 and 2 miles west of Simco Road in a portion of Section 20, Township 2 South, Range 4 East, Ada County, Idaho; and

WHEREAS, the suitability determination entails review and analysis of a proposed CAFO site that identifies the environmental risk categories related to the site, describes the factors that contribute to the environmental risks and sets forth any possible mitigation of risk, as defined in I.C. § 67-6529C(4).

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, the Board of Ada County Commissioners deems it appropriate to request the director of the Idaho Department of Agriculture to form a CAFO site advisory team to provide a suitability determination for the site, as provided by statute.
