



Ada County Weed Control Services

Each year, Ada County Weed Control treats thousands of acres for noxious weeds for more than 2,000 clients, agencies, businesses and individuals who contract our weed spraying services. Noxious weeds are a growing problem, and Ada County is aggressively working to reduce the impact these weeds can have on our quality of life.

Under Idaho State Code, Ada County must provide a program to control noxious weeds. Ada County Weed Control maintains the staff and equipment to provide this essential service and to help maintain the ecological health of our natural environment. State code requires property owners to control noxious weeds on their land. Ada County Weed Control treats noxious weeds on agricultural land if contracted by the landowner. If a landowner fails to control noxious weeds on their land, Ada County will treat the infestation(s) and bill the property owner for the weed control efforts.

Weed Mapping and Inventory

The first line of defense against noxious weeds is knowing where the infestations are and the history of successful treatment options. Using mobile mapping technology, weed crews have instant access to the location and treatment records of various noxious weed sites. Crews are also able to digitally map and update information on new or existing sites while in the field.

Roadside Weed Control

If you haven't seen our roadside spraying trucks while out and about in Ada County, watch for us! We contract with the Ada County Highway District to control noxious weed infestations on the district's arterial streets and highways.



Off-Road Weed Control

Residents can contract with Ada County Weed Control for farm and field noxious weed control assistance. There is an hourly fee for this service. We have spray trucks and ATVs equipped for pasture and rangeland weed control, and can also treat noxious weeds in farm yards, and along fence rows, commercial lots, ditches and/or dams. We do not provide lawn care or insect control, but many local private companies offer those services.



Rangeland Weed Control

Ada County monitors and responds to noxious weed infestations found on public lands. Ada County Weed Control tries to catch small weed infestations on public lands before they grow to become a more serious threat.



Weed Control Consultation

Weed control can be difficult when you aren't familiar with the herbicides available. There are dozens of products that might solve your specific noxious weed problem, but knowing which one, and at what time of the year it will be most effective, might require some help. That is where Ada County Weed Control comes in! If you have a specific weed problem, we encourage you call for advice.
